

STUDENT WORKSHOP OPPORTUNITIES

FABULOUS FLOWERS OF FLORIDA (CHALLENGES 5A and 5B)

On **Saturday, December 10, from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.**, Fairchild will host a one-day workshop for a maximum of 200 middle and high school students, selected by their schools, who are participating in this year's art challenge: "Fabulous Flowers of Florida."

Learn about the purpose of flowers and their relationship to the environment. The day starts with a presentation by Mary Keppler, Fairchild's Elementary Programs Coordinator. Students will work outdoors in small groups with teacher mentors, sketching and drawing plant life. Professional artists will also be available to mentor students.

Teachers may register up to eight students and two teachers or chaperones per school from Wednesday, November 2 to Wednesday, November 30 only. During the registration period, the available spaces will be filled on a first-come, first-served basis. Schools/students are responsible for transportation and all art supplies. Although lunch is not provided, we encourage students to bring a bag lunch and continue to enjoy Fairchild following the workshop. Please see Challenges 5A and 5B and our website for more details.
